

Camp Lucy Rules & Policies

1. All dogs attending must have a current Rabies Immunization Certificate.
2. Minors (under 18 years of age) must be accompanied by parent or guardian
3. Maximum of two dogs per camper unless otherwise approved.
4. Dogs must be well socialized and house trained (except for puppies) and nonaggressive toward people and other dogs. If your dog has been aggressive toward people or other dogs, they may not attend Camp Lucy.
5. Dogs in season may not attend Camp Lucy.
6. Dogs must be in reasonably good health, free of contagious disease and fleas and up to date on immunizations or titers.
7. Dogs must be on lead during class sessions and during all camp activities except during the water/ beach activities. To avoid entanglement or injury, Flexi leads are not permitted in classes or when attending camp activities. They may be used when exercising or walking dogs in fields or trails.
8. All dogs should wear a well-fitted buckle collar with identification, license and rabies tag.
9. If you routinely use a Halti or Gentle Leader you should use it at camp.
Positive and motivational training techniques should be used by attendees at Camp Lucy.
10. Camp Lucy Attendees are required to “Scoop Poop” immediately. P.U.P. (Pick Up Poop) stations and disposal buckets will be found throughout the campgrounds.
11. There is no smoking in any camp building or during camp activities.
12. The use of the lake/waterfront is at the camper’s own risk.
13. TGFLL Camp Lucy reserves the right to expel without refund, at their discretion, any camper for disruptive or unsafe behavior by human or dog.
